

When traveling with YUWIWEL® (navepegritide)

YUWIWEL travel checklist

- ✓ **My child has enough YUWIWEL, syringes, and needles for the duration of the trip.**
Take extra supplies just in case there are any unexpected travel delays. You may need to show prescription labels when traveling with medication, so also check ahead of time about domestic and international requirements.
- ✓ **My child's YUWIWEL medicine, syringes, and needles are all in the provided single injection kit.**
It's easier to find necessary supplies if you keep them all together in one place.
- ✓ **My child's YUWIWEL medicine is easily accessible while traveling.**
If traveling by plane, YUWIWEL should be stored in carry-on luggage to ensure it does not get lost. During the trip, YUWIWEL should be given exactly as your child's doctor has instructed.
- ✓ **My child's medical records are handy.**
Having a list of your child's current medications or a card with information about your child's condition would be helpful in case there is ever a health-related emergency.

What is YUWIWEL?

YUWIWEL is a prescription medicine used to increase linear growth in children 2 years and older with achondroplasia with open growth plates (epiphyses).

YUWIWEL is approved under accelerated approval based on an improvement in annualized growth velocity. Continued approval may be contingent upon verification and description of clinical benefit in confirmatory trials.


IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

What are the possible side effects of YUWIWEL?

YUWIWEL may cause serious side effects, including risk of low blood pressure. If your child experiences a decrease in blood pressure or symptoms of low blood pressure (dizziness, feeling tired, and/or nausea) while being treated with YUWIWEL, call your child's healthcare provider.

The most common side effects of YUWIWEL include injection site reactions (redness, itching, skin discoloration, bleeding, swelling, bruising, pain, and blistering).

Getting ready to travel

4 strategies for a successful trip

It's important to always be prepared when traveling. **Use these tips to ensure you have everything covered before you leave:**

- 1 Talk with your child's doctor if you are traveling with YUWIWEL.**
There may need to be a change in when your child's medicine is given due to the time difference. You may also be required to have your child's doctor complete a Letter of Medical Necessity for travel.
- 2 Double check that you have enough YUWIWEL for the entire trip.**
Some insurance plans will only allow for a 1-month supply of prescription medications at a time. If you are traveling for longer than a month, work with your doctor and insurance company to get the amount of medicine your child needs.
- 3 Ask your insurance provider if you have coverage when traveling internationally.**
If yes, remember to bring the insurance cards with you. If not, consider buying additional insurance that covers healthcare at your destination.
- 4 If traveling abroad, look up the closest US embassy or consulate to your destination.**
They can help you find local medical services and are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION (continued)

Before you give YUWIWEL to your child, tell the healthcare provider about all of your child's medical conditions, including if they:

- have kidney problems
- are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. It is not known if YUWIWEL will harm the unborn baby
- are breastfeeding or plan to breastfeed. It is not known if YUWIWEL passes into breast milk

Tell the healthcare provider about all the medicines your child takes, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements.
